


1st Floor Exhibitions

A - Teeth in Popular Culture

Witness amazing teeth feats, marvel at unique cultural teeth traditions, trace what humans have done to their teeth and realize how teeth have made their way into popular culture for centuries.

B - Animals and their Teeth

Learn how your mouth compares to a shark or a horse. Analyze skulls from across the animal kingdom to figure out what they eat, if they have had more sets of teeth than you, and why every animal has a different smile.

C - The Prevention Gallery

F - George Washington's Gallery

G - The ADA Theater
